

Note Synth App

Several screen shots from the Note Synth app and descriptions of how to use the various controls are shown below. More details can be found in the 'Info' tab on the app.



The input meter monitors the input signal strength and turns red when the signal is too strong. The text below the meter shows the note(pitch) played.

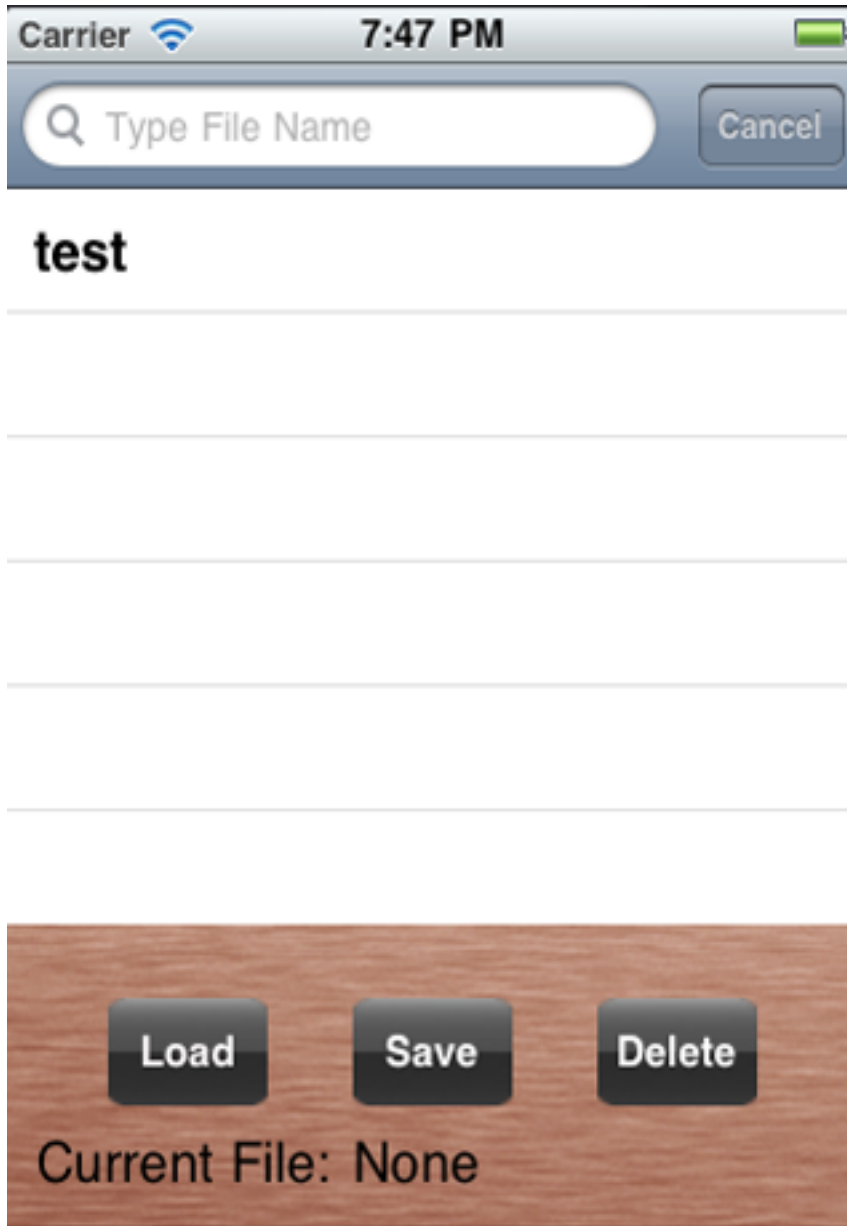
Audio Flowthrough switch disconnects the audio output from the audio input. The Sustain Notes control sets the number of current and previous notes that will play at once.

You can play two notes at once. For each note, set the MIDI channel and the note offset. You can offset the MIDI note from the note you are playing by up to 2 octaves.

You can control the current MIDI instrument by sending MIDI PC messages to the attached device. Set the MIDI PC channel and then change the program number.

The Event Threshold slider controls the sensitivity to the notes or chords played. Set it to a higher value for stronger input signals.

You can maintain a settings (preset) library using the "Setting Files" screen shown in the figure below.



All of your current presets are shown in a list format. To open any of these, touch the preset name and then press Load.

After creating a new preset you can save it by pressing the Save button and then giving it a name.

You can delete presets by selecting them and then pressing the Delete button.
